**Position Description and Application**

**TITLE:**

Student Ambassador & Activities Board

**FUNCTION:**

To serve as student leaders, assist the Learner Services Team with new student orientation and registration, and to facilitate the campus activities and objectives of the Student Ambassador & Activities Board (SAAB) program as outlined by the Director of Student Life. Individual members of the SAAB are viewed as part of an organization of student leaders at NWACC.

**REPORTS TO:**

Director of Student Life

**DUTIES:**

**Campus Activities**

- To plan all student activities on campus, actively participate in events, and to support and encourage other students to become involved in campus activities.
- To participate in an ongoing evaluation process regarding the campus activities program.

**Campus Tours**

- To give campus tours to prospective students.
- To coordinate campus tours with the Office of Admissions.

**Student Registration**

- To work with faculty, staff, student leaders, and members of the administration to facilitate the success of all aspects of the registration process.
- To act as a paraprofessional in presenting and distributing information to new students about a variety of aspects regarding the NorthWest Arkansas Community College campus throughout the registration period.
- To serve as a team leader/guide/assistant during New Student Orientation.

**Additional Duties**

- To represent NWACC at college and community functions.
- To speak in the community about NWACC.
- To serve as an ambassador of NorthWest Arkansas Community College in a variety of structured and informal formats.
- To plan and participate in a community service project each semester.
- To assist in writing articles for the student newspaper.
- To serve on college committees.
- To perform other duties as assigned by the Director of Student Life and the Dean of Students.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- SAAB applicants must be enrolled or plan to enroll for the 2015-2016 academic year at NorthWest Arkansas Community College, have at least a **2.75 overall cumulative grade point average** (at the time of application) and be enrolled or plan to enroll in at least twelve credit hours.
- No student may apply for or hold a SAAB position while on academic or disciplinary probation.
- SAAB applicants must complete an application and provide two (2) completed recommendation forms. Finalists will be asked to participate in group and individual interviews. Interviews will be scheduled for Friday, March 6th and on Friday, March 13th. Attendance at these interviews is required of all designated applicants.
- All selected SAAB members must participate in a three day training retreat on ***Tuesday, May 12 through Thursday, May 14.***

### **EXPECTATIONS:**

- The Student Ambassador & Activities Board conducts meetings on a weekly basis, Friday mornings 10:00 am – 12:00 pm. ***All SAAB members are required to participate in all meetings.***
- SAAB members must have two office hours per week to be used for SAAB business or giving campus tours.
- SAAB members are required to devote a minimum of 90 hours per semester to fulfill their contract.
- All SAAB members are required to assist with 30 hours of Orientation over the summer.
- SAAB members will also perform other duties as assigned by advisor.
- SAAB members will represent NorthWest Arkansas Community College in a positive manner at all times.
- SAAB members will work well with other Student Ambassadors, community members, and NWACC staff, faculty, and students.

### **COMPENSATION:**

- Student Ambassadors will receive a scholarship in the amount of \$900 per semester . The scholarship may only be used during the semester of service and may not be transferred over to additional semesters. If satisfactory performance has not been achieved by mid-semester, the SAAB advisor reserves the right to release the SAAB member from all duties and the remaining tuition payment will be the student's sole responsibility. Performance evaluation will be based on many factors as outlined in the SAAB contract. (A copy of the SAAB contract is available in the Office of Student Life.)
- In addition to the scholarship , SAAB members may receive the honor of being a student representative and peer role model. SAAB members will have many opportunities throughout their tenure of service to develop and polish their public speaking, communication, organizational, and leadership skills
- A Student Ambassador & Activities Board member's employment may be terminated if it is determined that he/she is not maintaining ethics befitting a paraprofessional, not performing satisfactorily, not able to work productively with other NorthWest Arkansas Community College staff/faculty/students, or jeopardizing the success of the program.
